

# Chamber presents annual business awards

Port Huron, MI - The Blue Water Area Chamber of Commerce concluded the month of October, designated as "Chamber of Commerce Month," by presenting awards to the Blue Water area's best in business during the 7<sup>th</sup> annual business awards program held on Thursday, October 28, 5-7PM at Black River Golf Club.
