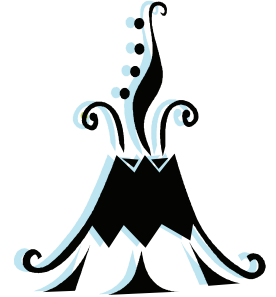


Fun Ideas to Keep Your Chapter Meetings

Rollicking!

1. Make a Volcano Cake in 7 minutes!

What You'll Need: Rice Cooker Plus by Pampered Chef
1 large cake platter
1 cup peanut butter
1 can chocolate frosting
1 chocolate cake mix



Mix chocolate cake mix according to the box and pour into rice cooker. Add one cup peanut butter to the center of the batter. (Do not stir.) Add 1 cup of chocolate frosting (or even more!) on top of the peanut butter. (Do not stir.) Put lid on the rice cooker and cook in the microwave on high for 7 minutes.

Take out of microwave and flip onto large cake platter (As everyone watches!) See the fabulous eruption of chocolate and peanut butter! Yum! Yum! Cut and serve. (Serves 1 to 12 generously!)

2. Celebrate the New Year!

4. February is Valentine's Month

Could you have a secret Valentine for the whole month and love them up silently and secretly? At the Chapter Meeting could you all dress in red and reveal your secret Valentines while giving Valentines to all of your girlfriends?

5. Host a Slumber Party!

This might be a great time to come to a Chapter Meeting dressed in your jammies for a good old fashioned Slumber Party! Serve Pop Corn and Pop! Keep the theme going by bringing boxes of breakfast cereal to donate to a local Shelter (as your volunteer service project)! Give a prize for the best slippers or hairnet!



6. Chick Flick Time!

Watching a girlie movie is a great idea for a slumber party or you may prefer a Stand Up Comic on video or DVD. Anita Renfroe is a fabulous comedian that would make any group of girlfriends laugh! 9. Garden Party

Everyone who comes to the Chapter Meeting brings a perennial (or 2 or 3 or 4) from their own garden to exchange! Everyone goes home with new perennials to plant!

11. Jewelry Exchange



Recycling at its BEST is a JEWELRY EXCHANGE! Promote a jewelry exchange far and wide and you are sure to get a crowd of girlfriends to attend. Everyone has jewelry in a jewelry box that never gets worn, right? Sounds like a Chapter Meeting that no one would want to miss!

If you haven't hula hooped lately you just haven't been having enough fun! Bring a couple of hula hoops to your next Chapter Meeting and have a contest! (It won't take long!) This is a great twist to add to a summer pool party.

13. Ole!

May is also the month of Cinco De Mayo which is a fun time to do a “Walking Taco” Chapter Meeting. To make a “Walking Taco” follow these simple instructions:



Crush a bag of Fritos (or Doritos) and add taco meat, (directly to the bag—no plates!) add shredded lettuce, salsa, onions, and cheese too. Then stick a fork in it!

Yum! Yum! You just have to have one to believe how delicious they are! Have everyone show up wearing a sombrero (and riding a donkey!)

14. Vintage Hats & Tea!

17. CHOCOLATE!

22. Make Bubbles!

25. COOKIES!

Hold a Christmas Cookie Exchange in December. Each Chapter member brings 8 dozen (or so) of the same cookies and goes home with dozens and dozens and dozens of different cookies!
